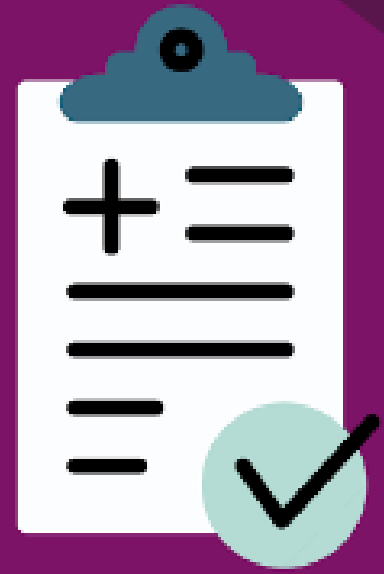

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WHAT IS UDL?

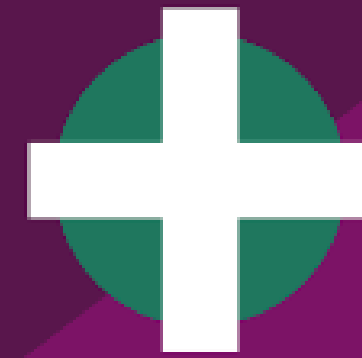
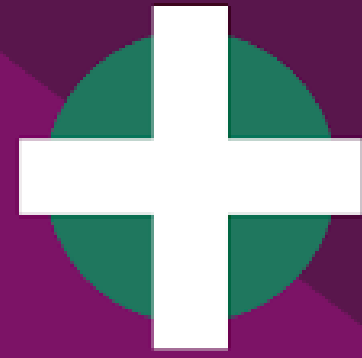
An educational framework

- Based on research on brain science and learning
- Focused on maintaining high academic expectations for students
- Allows educators to proactively plan for barriers in their lesson design
- Gives students voice and choice in the learning,
- Challenges and supports all students, regardless of their differences

UDL FRAMEWORK

A framework is a set of principles, or beliefs and values, that guide our work. A UDL Practitioner **believes:**



Students don't have to do the same things at the same time. Variability is the rule, not the exception.



All students can work toward the same firm goals and grade-level standards.



All students will become expert learners if barriers are removed.

WHY UDL?

Traditional Teaching	Differentiated Instruction	UDL
Static	Reactive	Proactive
Evaluates curriculum	Evaluates students	Evaluates environment, classroom, culture
Follows Script	Cause/Effect	Intentional
Teaches lesson and follows unit as designed	Retrofits instruction by providing accommodations	Designs instruction prior to arrival of students
Focuses on the "average" student	Focuses on individual ability	Focuses on variability
<i>Ignores barriers</i>	<i>Works around barriers</i>	<i>Removes barriers</i>

- Start with your standards & objectives
- Backward design
 - What do you want students to be able to master at the end of the lesson and what is acceptance evidence of that?
- Incorporate UDL principles
 - **Engagement**: How can I engage all students in my class?
 - **Representation**: How can I present information in ways that reach all learners?
 - **Action & Expression**: How can I offer purposeful options for students to show what they know?
- Student Feedback
 - Check in with your students to see what worked & didn't and make adjustments
- Grow from your mistakes!
